Academic Focus

Sight Words: review all sight words.

Language Arts: This week, we will focus on making connections between illustrations and text; finding text evidence: text features; and compare/contrast realistic fiction and informational text. In phonics, we will be reviewing the "th" and "sh" word family.

Writing: This week, we will begin our Narrative Writing unit. We will be introducing how to write stories with a beginning, middle, and end using pictures and words.

Math: Students will be solving subtraction problems and use number sentences to represent their thinking.
