### Academic Focus

**Sight Words:** what, put

**Language Arts:** This week, we will focus on making connections between illustrations and text; finding text evidence and comparing/contrasting. In phonics, we will be focusing on blending sounds to make words and the "th" word family.

**Writing:** This week, we will begin our Narrative Writing unit. We will be introducing how to write stories with a beginning, middle, and end using pictures and words.

**Math:** Students will be learning to solve a variety of addition problems and use number sentences to represent their thinking. We will also explore many ways to represent addition by using concrete objects and drawings.
