## Academic Focus

Sight Words: what, put
Language Arts: This week, we will focus on making connections between illustrations and text $t_{j}$ finding tex $\dagger$ evidence and comparing/contrasting. In phonics, we will be focusing on blending sounds to make words and the "th" word family.

Writing: This week, we will begin our Narrative Writing unit. We will be introducing how to write stories with a beginning, middle, and end using pictures and words.

Math: Students will be learning to solve a variety of addition problems and use number sentences to represent their thinking. We will also explore many ways to represent addition by using concrete objects and drawings.
